

- 2 x Crib Sheets




A WARNING: Ensure that you follow all instructions carefully for the safe assembly, attachment, and packing away of the crib. Save all the parts for repeated use.


Assembling the Crib

Remove from bag

 Remove the crib from the travel storage bag by unzipping it and sliding the bag off on a flat surface.




2. Lay the crib down on a flat surface and unfold the two legs until they are upright.







3. Slot the mattress base support frame into place.



 Attach the four Velcro strips on the base of the crib body to secure the frame and crib body together.



5. Turn the crib over to stand on its feet. Insert the lower tray at all four corners until it locks securely in place.




6. Then, securely attach the under flaps at each end using the velcro.



- 7. Place the mattress in the crib, and the crib is ready for standalone use.
- A WARNING: Never use with another mattress on top.




- 8. The height is adjustable on either side using the press buttons located on each top side.
- **MARNING:** When reclining the crib, ensure the height difference between the head and foot end is no be more than 10°.
- A WARNING: Do not use the reclining feature when the crib is attached to the bed.



Rocking Function of the Crib

Standing Mode

To use as a stand alone crib or a rocking crib keep the crib in standing mode. Place the crib in the room clear of any near furniture or walls etc. so it is safe to use.




Rocking Mode

To use the rocking mode function adjust both sides of the crib legs by simultaneously pressing the release catches and turning the rocker base down so the crib can rock side to side.


- ▲ WARNING: The crib should be locked in the fixed position when the child is left unattended.
- ▲ WARNING: Never violently rock the crib.
- ▲ WARNING: Do not use rocking feature when the crib is attached to the bed.

Ensure you follow these steps carefully for the safe assembly of the crib.




Attaching the Crib to a Bed for Co-sleeping


 Position the crib on the side of the bed.




2. Unzip the two access zips on either side of the upper crib.




3. Press the buttons on the underside of the crib top rail



4. Lift the front crib section rim to create the opening.





5. Secure the crib drop side in place using the velcro straps.




- Adjust the crib's height to match the top of the bed mattress, ensuring that the opening at the bottom is in line with the top of the mattress.
- Max. bed and mattress height: 520mm

Min. bed and mattress height: 400mm






 Take the restraint straps and attach them to the centre point of each side of the crib.




- 8. Stretch out the two attachment straps over the bed base and under the mattress. Adjust them with the buckle to securely fasten the crib to the bed so that there is NO GAP between the bed and the crib along the entire side.
- ▲ WARNING: The crib must be securely attached to the bed for safe use.




Packing Away The Crib


1. Detach the crib from the bed.




2. Remove the mattress.




3. Undo the base tray by undoing the side Velcro and pressing the locks at each corner to release the base bars. Remove the base tray from the crib.



4. Undo the four lower corner crib Velcro fasteners for the metal base frame and remove the base frame.



- 5. Turn the crib over and fold the legs inwards.
- 6. Place all the components into the crib bag and secure it for traveling or storage.





Care & Maintenance

All assembly fittings that can be should always be tightened properly and that care should be taken that no screws are loose, because a child could trap parts of the body or clothing (e.g. strings, necklaces, ribbons for babies' dummies, etc.), which would pose a risk of strangulation.

- To prolong the life of your crib, keep it clean and do not leave in the direct sunlight for extended periods of time.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners. Do not soak in water.
- Removable fabric covers and trims may be cleaned using warm water with a house-hold soap or a mild detergent. Allow it to dry fully, preferably away from direct sunlight.
- Always store your product in a clean dry place.
- Do not leave in the boot of car.
- · Do not allow this product to come in contact with sand or salt water, sand causes corrosion and salt water the formation of rust.
- · Do not dry clean or use bleach.
- · Do not machine wash, tumble or spin dry. Fabric and frame may be cleaned using a damp sponge with soap or mild detergent. The mattress can be washed by hand (see washing label). Allow it to dry completely before folding or storing it away.
- In some climates the parts may be affected by mould and mildew. To help prevent this occurring, do not fold or store the product if it is damp or wet.
- Always store the product in a well ventilated area.
- Always check parts regularly for tightness of screws, nuts and other fasteners, tighten if required. To maintain the safety of your crib, seek prompt repairs for bent, torn, worn or broken parts.
- Use only parts and accessories approved by the supplier.

Precautions For Product Use

- DO NOT use the crib if any part is broken, damaged, torn or missing and use only spare parts approved by the manufacturer. Contact Amana for replacement parts and instructional literature if needed.
- · Damage caused by overloading or wrong folding does not fall under the warranty.
- · Prolonged exposure to sunshine may cause changes in the colour of materials and fabrics.
- Do not expose this product to extreme temperatures. Extreme sunshine or temperatures may cause colour changes or broken parts.
- · Check that the locking mechanisms are fully engaged before using the crib
- To avoid injury ensure that your child is kept away when unfolding and folding the crib.
- Do not fold the crib with the child in it.
- Keep the crib away from children when not in use.
- The use of this crib is recommended for 1 child only.
- Never move the crib while the child is in it.
- Only use the crib on a firm and horizontal level floor.

Note that the fabric patterns, colour pictures and accessories on this product in this user guide may vary from that of the product that you have purchased. If one or more of the parts are missing or broken, please contact the store where you bought the product before using.

Mattress Base


🔼 WARNING: Only use the mattress sold with this crib, do not add a second mattress on this one, suffocation hazards.

Warnings

- A DANGER: Always completely raise the drop side when not attached to the adult's bed.
- WARNING: Read all instructions before assembling and using the product.
- **A WARNING:** Do not use this product without reading the instructions for use first.
- A WARNING: Stop using the product as soon as the child can sit or kneel or pull itself up.
- A WARNING: Placing additional items in the product may cause suffocation.
- A WARNING: Do not place the product close to another product, which could present a danger of suffocation or strangulation, e.g. strings, blind/ curtain cords, etc.
- A WARNING: Do not use more than one mattress in the product.
- 🛕 WARNING: To avoid hazards from the child's neck being caught on the top rail on the side that is next to the adult bed, the top rail must not be higher than the adult bed mattress.
- **MARNING:** To avoid the risk of your child being strangled by the attachment system to the adult's bed shall always be kept away from and out of the crib.
- A WARNING: Only use the mattress sold with this crib, do not add a second mattress on this one, suffocation hazards.
- **MARNING:** Never put the crib near steps or stairs.
- A WARNING: The crib shall not be used without the mattress base.
- A WARNING: Do not continue using the crib if parts are broken or if fabric is ripped or torn. Only use replacement parts approved by manufacturer.
- **MARNING:** Replace any damaged parts immediately.
- WARNING: The product should be placed on a horizontal floor.
- A WARNING: Young children should not be allowed to play unsupervised near the crib

- A WARNING: All assembly fittings should always be tightened properly and that care should be taken that no screws are loose, because a child could trap parts of the body or clothing (e.g. Strings, necklaces, ribbons for babies' dummies, etc.), which would pose a risk of strangulation.
- A WARNING: Be aware of the risk of burning cigarettes, open fires and other sources of strong heat, such as electric bar fires, gas fires, etc. in the near vicinity of the crib.
- A WARNING: Height from the floor to the top of the adult's bed mattress for which the crib is suitable - Max. height: 520mm / Min. height: 400mm
- **A WARNING:** Only use the attachment system provided and do not use other attachment systems.
- **MARNING:** There shall never be a gap between the lower side of the crib and the mattress of the adult bed.
- A WARNING: If there is any gap between the crib and the adult bed DO NOT use product.
- A WARNING: Use only the mattress provided by manufacturer. NEVER add a pillow, comforter or another mattress for padding.
- **A WARNING:** Failure to follow these warnings and instructions could result in serious injury or death.
- A WARNING: FALL HAZARD To help prevent falls, do not use this product when infant begins to push up on hands and knees or has reached manufacturer's recommended maximum weight of 9kg, whichever comes first.
- A WARNING: SUFFOCATION HAZARD Infants have suffocate: In Gaps between extra padding and side of the crib, and on soft bedding.
- A WARNING: If a sheet is used with the mattress, use only the one provided by the crib manufacturer or one specifically designed to fit the dimension of the crib mattress.
- A WARNING: To reduce the risk of SIDS, paediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their backs to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your physician.
- 🛕 WARNING: Strings can cause strangulation! Do not place items with a string around a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords. Do not suspend strings over the crib or attach strings to toys.

- A WARNING: DO NOT use crib if any parts are missing, damaged, or broken. Contact Amana for replacement parts and instructional literature if needed. DO NOT substitute parts.
- **A WARNING:** Always read and follow assembly instructions for each product use mode (bedside sleeper, stand alone crib or rocking crib).
- **A WARNING:** Assemble product according to manufacturer's instructions for ANY use mode—bedside sleeper as well as the stand alone crib or rocking crib.
- **A WARNING:** This bedside sleeper is designed for use only with adult beds that are between 400mm - 520mm from the floor to the top of the adult mattress
- A WARNING: The types of adult beds (BELOW FIG.) with which the crib CAN OR CANNOT be used in the bedside sleeper mode.




- A WARNING: FALL HAZARD Always check that the crib is securely locked on the base/stand pulling upwards on the crib top.
- WARNING: The bedside sleepers mode should never be used in an inclined position.
- A WARNING: To prevent a suffocation hazard from entrapment, the crib shall be properly secured to the adult bed using the attachment system.
- **A WARNING:** A crib is designed to provide a sleeping area for an infant until he or she begins to push up on hands and knees or approximately 5 months of age. Move your child to another sleeping product when your child reaches this stage.

- WARNING: ENTRAPMENT HAZARD To prevent death from entrapment, the crib must be properly secured to adult bed using the attachment system when used in the bedside sleeper mode.
 - There must be no more than 13mm gap between the crib in bedside sleeper mode and the adult bed.
 - Check tightness before each use by pulling the crib sleeper in a direction away from adult bed.
 - If gap exceeds 13mm, DO NOT use product.
 - · Do not fill the gap with pillows, blankets or other items that are suffocation hazards.
- A WARNING: Always use ALL required parts for each use mode. Check user guide for a list of required parts.
- A WARNING: Periodically check product for loose, damaged, or missing parts.
- **A WARNING:** The attachment system must always be used in bedside sleeper mode.
- WARNING: Not intended for carrying baby
- **A WARNING:** NEVER use for a baby who is able to sit upright unassisted.
- **A WARNING:** NEVER place a child under 3kg or over 9kg in the crib.
- A WARNING: NEVER move while child is in crib.
- A WARNING: Never place the crib on a counter-top, table, on or near steps or on other elevated surfaces.
- 🛕 WARNING: Please keep all packaging material away from babies and children, to prevent suffocation.
